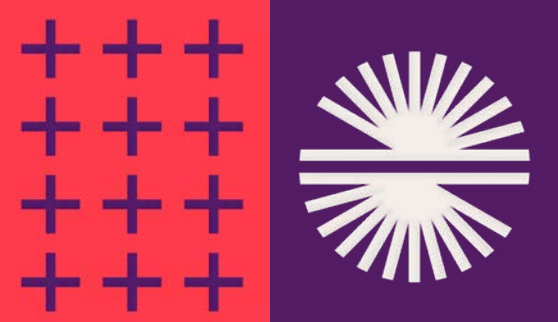
## Accommodation

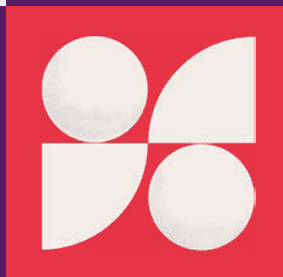
