Open Day Arrival Instructions

October 2019

Arriving by Car

To minimise traffic congestion and long delays on campus, we've put together some arrival instructions to follow on our Open Day.

The sat-nav for the University is **CV4 7AL**. Please do not use your satnav when on the final approach to campus. Please follow the yellow Open Day signs instead as they will direct you to the closest available car park. Parking will be available from 8:30am – 5:30pm,

Please allow extra time for your journey as the roads around campus will be very busy. We recommend arriving 45 minutes before your first session so you can get parked, check in and find your way around.

Parking charges for Kirby Corner and Lynchgate

Please be aware that there will be a £1 charge for parking in our Kirby Corner and Lynchgate multi-storey car parks. This is due to a condition of them being built. Where possible, please can you have the correct change to hand.

Please also note that there is a height restriction of 2.0 metres for vehicles entering these car parks. If your vehicle is above this, please let one of our staff know on the day and they will direct you to the closest alternative space.

On Arrival

When you arrive, you'll be greeted by a team of our Ambassadors in yellow t-shirts who will be able to answer any questions and direct you to the nearest Welcome and Information Point. These desks are based near all the key entry points to campus so you won't have to travel far. When you get to this point, we'll scan the barcode on your confirmation email (please have it ready on your phone or a print-out) and give you a printed copy of our Open Day Guide and a campus map. You'll then be free to enjoy your day and discover all that Warwick has to offer you.

Car parks and the closest Welcome and Information Point

For ease, please see below the closest Welcome and Information Point to each car park zone. If there is a bit of a queue and you have a session to get to, please feel free to visit any of our desks at any point in the day to check in and collect your guide.

Arriving by Train

One of the easiest ways to travel to our Open Days is by train. Our closest train stations are Coventry (with frequent services direct from London and Birmingham) and Warwick Parkway (convenient for many routes from the South).

We will be offering a free shuttle bus service to and from campus from both stations throughout the day. Look out for our Student Ambassadors in yellow t-shirts who will be at the station until 12 noon, to help direct you.

The shuttle buses will run regularly from 8.30am until 5pm. The journey between campus and both stations is around 25 minutes so please do leave enough time to travel and register at one of our Information Points.

Arriving by Bus or Coach

There are a number of national coach services that arrive at Coventry Pool Meadow bus station. Further information can be found [here](#). Once you have arrived in Coventry, there are frequent [local bus services](#) to the University, most of which stop at our Bus Interchange. This is in the centre of campus and will give you easy access to most of campus.

Arriving by Taxi

If you are arriving by taxi, please direct your driver to the taxi rank at the Bus Interchange. This is in the centre of campus and will give you easy access to most of campus.

Travelling from overseas

Our nearest airport is Birmingham International. From there, you can travel by train (via Coventry train station) or by taxi. There will be a free shuttle to campus from Coventry station. Look out for our Student Ambassadors in yellow t-shirts who will be at the station until 12 noon, to help direct you.

On Arrival

When you arrive, please make your way to your closest Welcome and Information Point where you'll be greeted by a team of our Ambassadors in yellow t-shirts who will be able to answer any questions you may have. These desks are based near all the key entry points to campus so you won't have to travel far.

When you get to one of these points, we'll scan the barcode on your confirmation email (please have it ready on your phone or a print-out) and give you a printed copy of our Open Day Guide and a campus map. You'll then be free to enjoy your day and discover all that Warwick has to offer you.
