

Guidance for using the washing station

Car washing procedure

1. Only wash in the designated area. Ensure there are no apparent leaks of oil and fuel
2. Rinse vehicle



3. Use "1off squirt" only off the tub in the washing bucket **Do not exceed quantity**
4. Mix with water
5. Scrub vehicle
6. Rinse vehicle to take washing product and dirt away
7. Drive away

Precautionary statements

First aid measures

- Description of first aid measures
 - Inhalation Not relevant. Unlikely route of exposure as the product does not contain volatile substances.
 - Ingestion Rinse mouth thoroughly with water. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues.
 - Skin contact Rinse with water.
 - Eye contact Remove any contact lenses and open eyelids wide apart. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention promptly if symptoms occur after washing.
- Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed
 - Inhalation No specific symptoms known.
 - Ingestion No specific symptoms known.
 - Skin contact Prolonged contact may cause redness, irritation and dry skin.
 - Eye contact May cause temporary eye irritation.

 - Notes for the doctor = No specific recommendations.

- Methods for cleaning up Flush away spillage with plenty of water. Avoid contamination of ponds or watercourses with
- washing down water. Absorb spillage with non-combustible,

- Usage precautions = Avoid contact with eyes.

- Storage precautions Store in closed original container at temperatures between 0° C and 30° C.
