

# 13 Sustainability on Campus



**YOUR CHALLENGE:** Can you colour in the image, which includes some of the protected species you can find on campus?

The Sustainability Team run a wide range of wildlife surveys across campus, working with staff, students and local partners to better understand the species that live here. These include surveys of moths, butterflies, small mammals (like mice and voles), reptiles and

hedgehogs, alongside bird and pollinator nature walks. The team also use wildlife cameras to monitor what's going on, and have captured species such as otters, badgers and deer on them. They've also reintroduced the white-clawed crayfish to campus.

This work helps to build a detailed picture of biodiversity across campus and makes sure we are doing what we can to protect it. ★
