How to Get Here

Resonate Festival - Day Out takes place on the University of Warwick campus, in and between Warwick Arts Centre, Faculty of Arts Building (the orange one) and the Oculus Building (curved roof).

The main postcode to follow is **CV4 7AL**.

Main ways to get here: walk, cycle, bus, car.

Parking

If you are driving it will cost £1 to park for the entire day.

Parking can be paid for in advance or on the day.

Please use [this link](#) (or scan the QR code) to go directly to the parking payments page. Alternatively, you will find parking payment machines in the foyer of Warwick Arts Centre.



The best places to park are Cryfield Village, Central Campus (signed as car park 10, 9 or 8) and Kirby Corner car parks. You can follow signs to each of these once close to or on campus.

On Arrival

Please come to the check-in desk located in Warwick Arts Centre foyer and scan your general admission QR code (this will be contained in an email sent to you at the time of booking).

Once checked in you will be given one voucher per person. This voucher can be exchanged at Benugo for one drink or in the foyer of the Oculus for one can of drink and one individual snack.

James Campbell is **currently sold out** but we will be operating a **spare seat queue in case of no-shows** on the day which will be given out on a first come first serve basis. If you wish to queue, please head to The Studio where you will be advised on where to stand.

Stefan Gates' Gastronomaut Show is in the Butterworth Hall which has greater capacity so there is a higher likelihood of getting a seat there if you have not booked a show ticket.
